

**Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission

April 2017**



The Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission held its monthly hearing April 11, 2017 at 9 a.m. Commissioners attending were Bridget Hill, Tom Drea, Mark Doelger and Tom Fitzsimmons. Also attending the hearing were Supervisor Mark Watson and Attorneys Eric Easton and Michael Armstrong.

**The April 2017 Hearing docket showed:**

- 270 total applications
- 44 applications continued
- 36 applications withdrawn
- 113 returned for admin processing
- 68 examiner hearings
- 5 aquifers/units hearings
- 0 applications to be heard by the Commission
- 4 preliminary matters
