

Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission Hearing Wrap-up Report June 2018



The Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission held its monthly hearing June 12, 2018 at 9 a.m. Commissioners present were Bridget Hill, Erin Campbell and Ken Hendricks. Also representing the WOGCC were Supervisor Mark Watson and Attorneys Eric Easton and Michael Armstrong.

The June 2018 Hearing docket showed:

- 475 total applications
- 44 applications to be heard by the Commission
- 223 examiner hearings
- 4 aquifer/unit hearings
- 4 pit treatment hearings
- 32 returned for admin processing
- 54 applications continued
- 20 applications withdrawn
- 57 preliminary matters
- 37 sent to the APD docket

Before the Commission:

Docket 670-2016 Commission granted Powder Battalion Holdings, LLC a final extension until August 14, 2018 to comply with the requirements of the Supplemental Order.

Docket 1846-2018 Commission approved staff's recommendation to revoke Stealth Energy USA, Inc.'s bond and to plug and abandon their two wells in Natrona County.

Docket 1847-2018 Commission approved staff's recommendation to revoke Cammeran Petroleum, Inc.'s bond and to plug and abandon their three wells in Campbell County.

Docket 1848-2018 Commission granted Salt Creek Operating, Inc. a one month continuance.
