

## Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission Hearing Wrap-up Report July 2017



The Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission held its monthly hearing July 11, 2017 at 9 a.m. Commissioners attending were Governor Matt Mead, Bridget Hill, Tom Drea, Mark Doelger and Tom Fitzsimmons. Also attending the hearing were Deputy Supervisor Tom Kropatsch and Attorneys Eric Easton and Michael Armstrong.

### The July 2017 Hearing docket showed:

- 271 total applications
- 150 applications continued
- 26 applications withdrawn
- 0 returned for admin processing
- 83 examiner hearings
- 4 aquifers/units hearings
- 2 pit Treatment hearing
- 3 applications to be heard by the Commission
- 3 preliminary matters

### Preliminary Matters:

Docket 530 and 531-2017 In preliminary matters, the Commission approved EOG's request to continue their applications that are being protested by Navigation to August.

Docket 966-2017 Legal counsel for Ballard requested that their filing be continued to August. It was approved by the commission

### Before the Commission:

Docket 227-2016 Ultra Petroleum provided a one year review of their Lance Pool DSU approved by the Commission in 2016.

Docket 951-2017 Commission denied Merit's secondary recovery unitization application for the Whitetail CR Minn Unit secondary recovery.

Docket 1004-2017 Commission authorized Anschutz Exploration Corporation's request to flare 300 mcf/d until October 10, 2017 from the Mooney Draw 1H well pursuant to Chapter 3, Section 39(C) to reduce wellhead pressure to allow production in order to evaluate the well, to reduce pressure to allow fracturing stimulation and fracturing treatments and to evaluate the formation after the fracturing processes.
