

**Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission  
Supervisor's Report to Commission – Mark Watson  
June 2019**



**APDs:**

The number of APDs received in May 2019 was 3,301 – an increase of 718 APDs (or about 28 percent) from previous month.

**RIG COUNT:**

According to Drill Info, the rig count report for June 10, 2019 is 33 (down 2 from last month). The rig count according to Baker Hughes on June 7, 2019 is 32.

The busiest county is still Converse with 17 rigs (up 3 from last month)

The rig count this time last year count was 25 according to Baker Hughes' historical records.

**MONTHLY PRODUCTION:**

Wyoming oil production for March 2019 was 8,090,823 BOO and was up by approximately 12 percent from March of 2018.

Wyoming gas production for March 2019 was **135,332,527 MCF** and was down approximately 15 percent from February 2018.

**BONDS:**

The end of May 2019 bond report is as follows:

Total bond amount was \$213,275,332. Idle wells bond was \$150,061,659 which is approximately 70 percent of the total bond amount.

**FLARE:**

The volume of approved flared gas for March 2019 from 24 wells was 176,076 MCF total.

However, the actual flared volume of gas for the same time period was 53,384 MCF total; which is approximately 30 percent of the approved volume.

There are currently 5 oil wells flaring in excess of the 60 MCFD limit, in accordance with WOGCC Rule Chapter 3, Section 39(b); that requires Supervisor or Commission approval

**ORPHAN WELL UPDATE:**

In May, four (4) wells on the Ucross 2019 (Northwest Energy) were plugged completing this project.

The North Campbell 2019 is still facing muddy conditions. Thirty-one (31) High Plains and eight (8) Benchmark wells have been cemented.

The East Arvada 2019 project kicked off April 3<sup>rd</sup>, but there still are muddy conditions around the Powder River.

The Langley 2019 was awarded on June 6<sup>th</sup>, and the Spotted Horse 2019 project is slated to out soon
