Re: Survey Plats

All applications to drill (APD) submitted to the Wyoming Oil & Gas Conservation Commission (WOGCC) must include a signed survey plat that complies with the requirements of Chapter 3, Section 8(i). It has come to the attention of the WOGCC that a number of survey plats are being submitted with certification statements that do not meet the intent of the rule, which require surveyors to perform duties onsite. Failure to submit a compliant certification can be grounds for denying an APD. However, the WOGCC will allow operators to submit corrected survey plats with the required certification statement until February 29, 2019. After this date, any APD with a non-compliant survey plat may be denied. The following language must be included in the certification statement from the surveyor:

I, _____, a Licensed Professional Land Surveyor in the State of Wyoming, do hereby certify that this plat was made from data collected during an actual survey of the well pad and all other necessary locations performed by me or under my supervision and that the location and legal description presented for the surface hole location are true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
